

Considering the many breeding programs in the performance horse industry, mare/offspring owners and participants understandably become confused or unaware of making their offspring eligible to compete. Although some mare owners breed for showing prospects, some breed to sell, additionally some offspring are sold more than once before reaching show age. I highly recommend enrolling your offspring where required (ie: Canadian Supreme etc., though not all programs require this) by the designated deadlines, your program may not be to show, however it will increase marketability should you decide at some time to sell your offspring! I urge you as a mare owner, or owner of offspring from Smart Lil Player to notify me of any changes of ownership, as well to notify the new owner of this information I am attempting to compile as an overview of the "breeding Programs." The Breeding Program Associations must also be made aware of changes in ownership. Though these breeding program associations, as well as myself make efforts to track and record such changes, your assistance is necessary. The following information is a summation of these programs, an overview. Please refer to the association rules, guidelines etc. for complete information, the names and address's are noted here.
